

# GUIDELINES FOR CONTRIBUTORS

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Thank you for your interest in submitting an article to *ADVANCE for Speech-Language Pathologists & Audiologists*.

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Articles should be approximately 1,000 words in length. Longer articles must be approved by the editor. The article should follow the writing guidelines set forth in the *Associated Press (AP) Stylebook*. If you do not have access to the *AP Stylebook*, follow common writing rules, and the editor will make the necessary changes.

An author's biography should be included at the end of the article. It should list the credentials, professional title and current position of the author. A daytime phone number and e-mail address for each author must be included with the submission.

All statements based on published findings or data should be referenced appropriately. References should be listed in numerical order in the text and at the end of the article. References must include the exact name of the article, chapter, journal and/or book; authors; publisher (including city and state); year of publication; volume and number of the publication; and page numbers. Submissions without proper reference citations will not be accepted for publication.

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## SUBMISSION INFORMATION

E-mail is the preferred method of submitting the manuscript. When e-mailing an article, it can be sent attached as a Microsoft Word document or included in the body of the message.

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
